We use the internet in school:

- To carry out research

- To find out about different places on google maps
- To look up facts or words
- To access Purple Mash which is our learning zone
- To use programming tools like scratch and Wedo Lego
- To find useful images

We keep safe on the internet by:

- Using the Zip it, Block it, Flag it symbols on the computer
- Telling an adult if we see anything that is inappropriate or we don't like
- Only accessing sites that we have been told to use unless we have asked permission first
- Keeping our passwords to ourselves
- Never speaking to anyone that we do not know (e.g. opening an e mal from someone we don't know)
- Never giving out personal information
